

Revision of Merit /Distinction Pass Criteria of
Diploma in Library & Information Management By Laws

Current DLIM


- 17.
- 17.1 A candidate shall be deemed to have qualified for a Merit Pass if s/he at one and the same examination passes in all course units securing a minimum grand average of 65% with A grade passes in at least four papers and at least B grade passes in all the remaining papers.
- 17.2 A candidate shall be deemed to have qualified for a Distinction Pass if she/he at one and the same examination passes in all papers securing a minimum grand average of 70% with A grade passes in at least two papers and at least B grade passes in all the remaining papers.
- 17.3 A candidate shall be eligible for the award of Merit or Distinction Pass only when s/he took all the examinations leading to the DLIM on the first occasion on which s/he was qualified to take that examination unless the Senate determines for any valid reason that s/he is eligible for the award although s/he took the examination on a subsequent occasion.

In MTL /PGTL/FGLIS/DTL this is as follows;

- 17.1 A candidate shall be deemed to have qualified for a merit pass if s/he at one and the same examination passes in all papers and securing a minimum grand average of 65% with A grade passes in at least two papers and at least B grade passes in all the remaining papers.
- 17.2 A candidate shall be deemed to have qualified for a Distinction if he at one and the same examination passes in all papers securing a minimum grand average of 70% with A grade passes in at least four papers and at least B grade passes in all the remaining papers.

Relevant DLIM By Law should be changed as;
