BACKGROUND

The University of Colombo established a two-year Masters Degree Programme in International Relations in 1985.

From modest beginnings, the M.A. Degree Programme, the only one of its kind in Sri Lanka, has now developed into a full—fledged postgraduate programme catering on the average to about fifty (50) students annually.

COURSE

This is a two-year full time programme in which students are required to follow six courses in the first year and six courses in the second year and also to submit a Dissertation on a topic selected in consultation with the Coordinator. This is a SLQF Level 10 Qualification with a Learning Volume of 60 credits.

CALENDAR

The Academic year will commence in January 2026 and is divided into two terms of 25 weeks duration each; with short mid-term holidays.
