Postgraduate Diploma in Conflict and Peace Studies (Leading to Masters in Conflict & Peace Studies)

The Objective of this programme is to introduce concepts and theories of conflict, focusing on methods of analyzing them, and the ways and means of managing, transforming, and resolving them, through a survey of conflict literature. It will encourage students to scrutinize various types of conflicts in **social, cultural, ethnic, economic, political, developmental, environmental and other such spheres.**

Admission Requirements

A Bachelor's degree from a recognized University/ Institution in the relevant field;

OR

Any other Bachelor's degree, with prior learning/work experience in the relevant field;

OR

Relevant Professional qualification from a recognized professional body acceptable to the Faculty Board and the Senate of the University with prior learning/ work experience in the field of Conflict and Peace;

OR

Completion of NVQ level 7 (equivalent to Bachelor's degree in SLQF) with relevant work experience in the field of Conflict and Peace as determined by the Faculty Board and the Senate.

And

A good knowledge of English language and satisfactory performance at a selection test and/or selection interview.

The Faculty is drawn from academics at UOC and professionals who are actively engaged in the field of conflict resolution in Sri Lanka.
