**MAINTAINING UNIVERSITY ACTIVITIES UNDER THE COVID – 19 PANDEMIC SITUATION**

The Covid-19 pandemic, which is spreading rapidly as a global pandemic in many parts of the world is causing a rapid increase in the numbers of patients globally.

Due to this global pandemic, there is a rapid increase in the number of Covid-19 patients in Sri Lanka. Recently there has been an increase in the number of first and second contact patients reported at the University as well.

However, in the face of this pandemic, the University has arranged an expeditious programme to produce well qualified graduates for our nation by conducting academic activities as well as examinations while complying with government health guidelines.

The University has taken the following steps for the students and staff community to counter the Covid-19 pandemic.

It is a collective responsibility for us to maintain a “new normal” lifestyle while continuing higher education.

1. It has been decided to reserve the Boralessgamuwa Hostel for students and staff facing quarantine. The University administration will take action to provide hostel facilities for the first and second contacts.
2. The University has made arrangements to conduct the rapid antigen test for Covid 19 with financial assistance from the university when required and as per the recommendations of the University Medical Officer.
3. If an infected person with Covid-19 symptoms is reported within the University premises, on the advice and request of the UOC Medical Officer, the 1990 Ambulance service will be arranged.
4. In the event of a Covid-19 patient or close contact with university staff/student please communicate details to the Head of the department and University Medical Officer.
5. Students and staff advised to be quarantined should submit the quarantine Certificate issued by the MOH of their area when returning to work or before attending academic activities.
